





SNAP EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING

Metropolitan Community College has partnered with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) and Department of Labor (DOL) to empower families and individuals seeking better employment opportunities and better lives by offering the SNAP Next Step Employment and Training Program (SNAP E&T). SNAP E&T provides SNAP recipients who are unemployed or under employed the opportunity to complete education and training programs that will lead to a fulfilling and rewarding career with an increased earning potential.

Each participant will be paired with a Career Coach to work one-on-one to identify employment and training goals, programs of interest, and assist with overcoming any challenges along the way. Services include individualized job search and resume assistance, mock-interview opportunities, occupational and soft-skill training and credential opportunities.

You may be a good candidate if:

- You currently receive SNAP benefits or believe your qualify for SNAP benefits and would like to apply
- You are not receiving TANF/ADC benefits
- Your household has at least one work eligible adult (US Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident)
