<u>Announcement:</u> Kepro has undergone a merger and the Name is changing to Acentra. The software system is still Atrezzo, however, Acentra will be main Logo versus Kepro. The website domains will eventually change.

#### **PASRR Review**

- Medicaid cannot reimburse for room and board for days that a resident does NOT have a valid PASRR in place. This is a federal requirement with no exceptions.
- Important to read PASRR determinations.
  - o In a level II Determination Notification, you will find:
    - What condition
    - Requires & appropriate for nursing facility care
    - Number of days approved.
    - Requires/doesn't require specialized services
- If the facility uses Acentra's Admit/discharge feature for time limited PASRRs, Acentra will help you keep track and will notify you if you need to do another PASRR

## **NF LOC Review**

- When a facility receives the Notice of Role of Nursing Facility, that is the perfect time to make the referral. ALWAYS keep the fax transmittal report that shows the fax went through and was "ok"
- We have had several instances where the NF LOC was forgotten. It is highly important that the referral be made within the timeframes of the regulations.
- 471 NAC chapter 44 has all the requirements that need to be followed for the NF LOCs
- Special Circumstances Highlights
  - If the resident goes to the hospital and comes back to facility without stepping down, then the LOC is okay.
  - Medicaid if came in on hospice and they come off let us know as we will need to set nursing facility pay date. Hospice pay date is auto populated with day of admission as it meets the requirement for the NF LOC.
  - o The day Medicare stops request NFLOC.
  - Special Needs facilities and Out-Of-State are prior authorized we will get the PASRR in MMIS
    as one is required for all special needs residents and prior to a resident going out of state.

## Incorrect Calculations on the MDS assessments from 10.01.2023 through 11.13.2023

- CMS had incorrect calculations for 6 weeks and fixed this on 11.13.2023
- CMS made a new final validation report available to all facilities with the affected residents.
- Submission date in section Z at the bottom of the RAW record
  - o If the submission date is the 10<sup>th</sup> or prior of the month then on the care level report
  - If the submission date is the 11<sup>th</sup> or later of the month then it will be on the next month's care level report
- October November Claims
  - There will be a 1-time mass claim adjustment
  - Claims will pay at what MMIS has in its system
  - We get the HIPPS code from Z0100A\_recalculated

- Please remember to let us know if you have resident's that move into or out of a Medicaid certified bed.
- We do not need you to send a move from one Medicaid bed to another Medicaid bed.
