

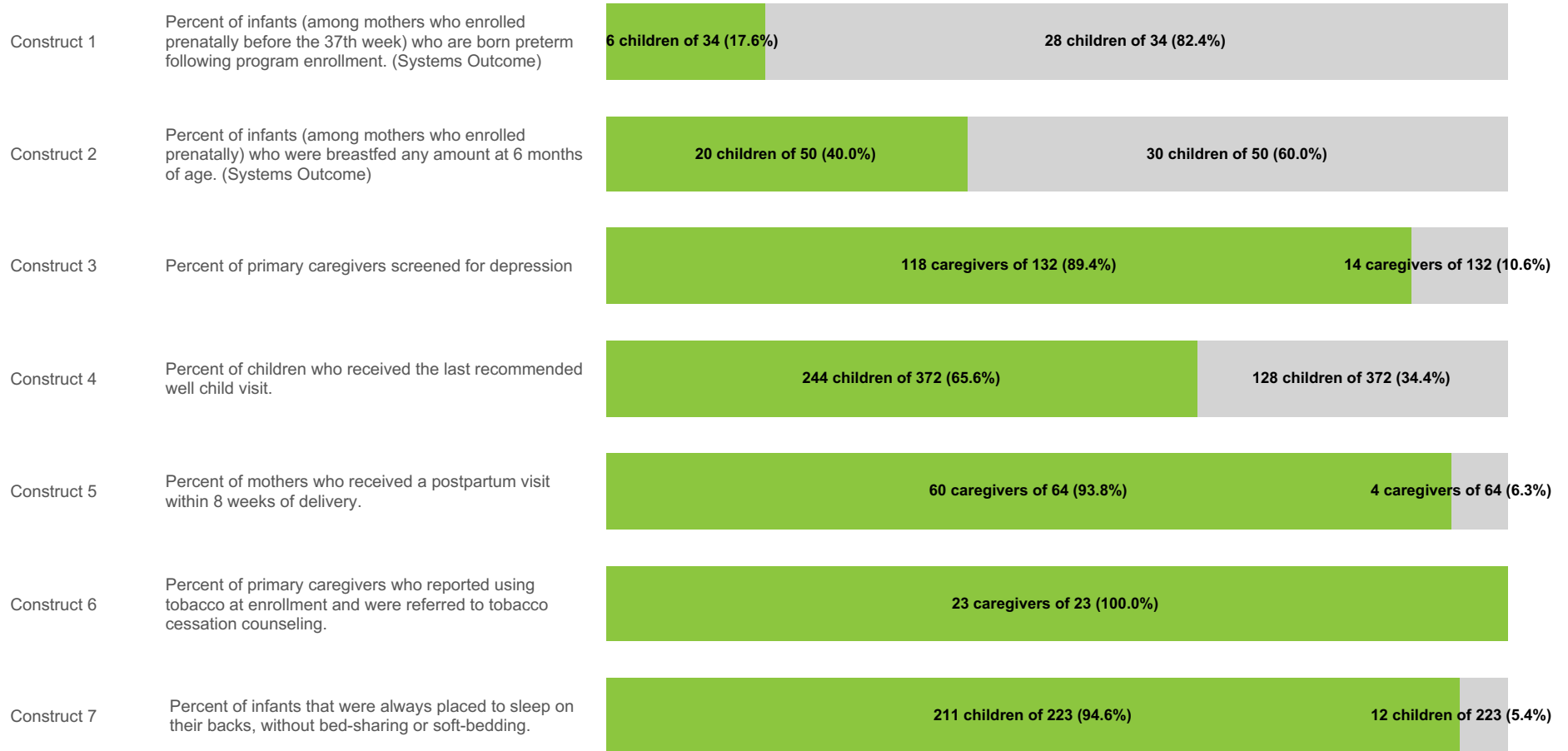

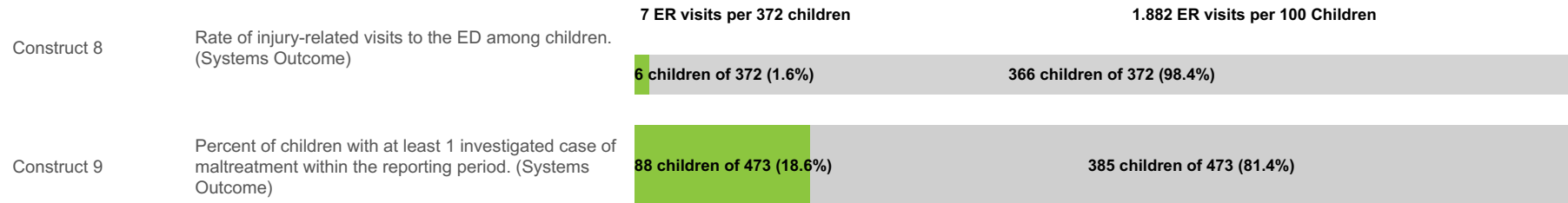
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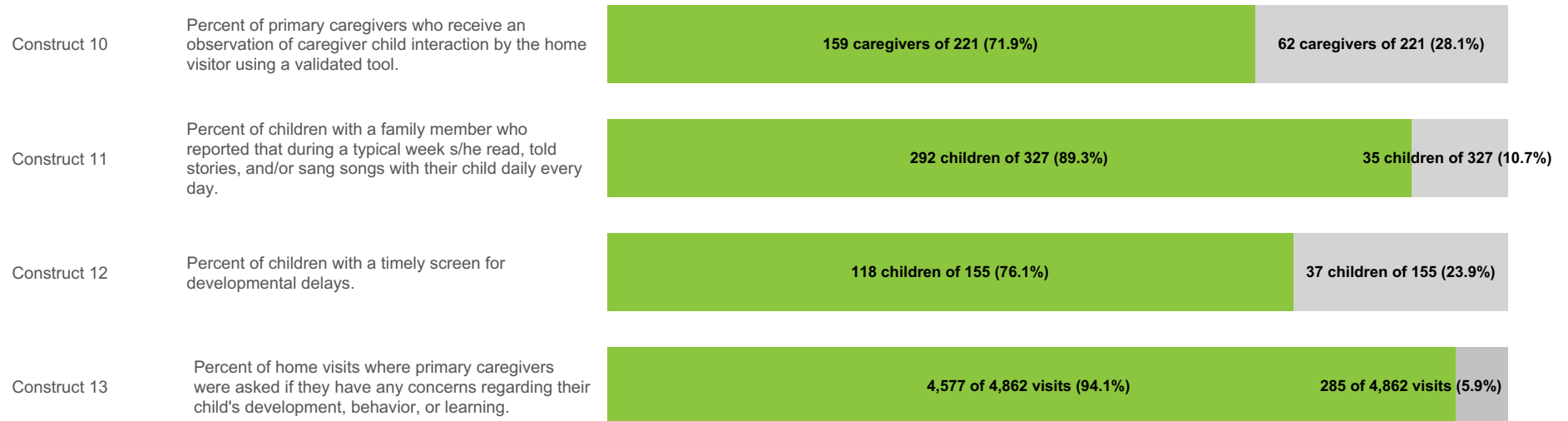

Construct 14 Percent of primary caregivers enrolled who are screened for IPV within 3 months of enrollment.

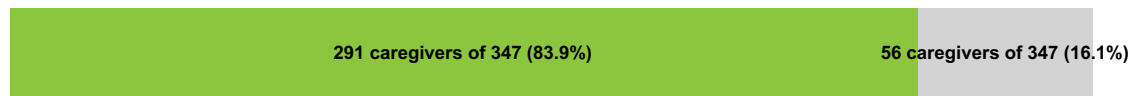


Benchmark 5 - Family Economic Self Sufficiency

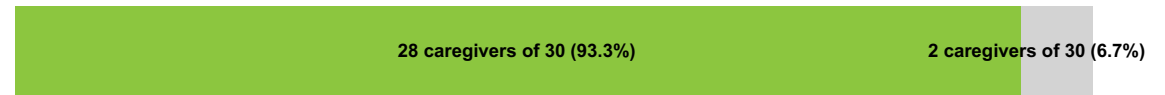


Construct 16 Percent of primary caregivers who had continuous health insurance coverage for at least 6 consecutive months. (Systems Outcome)

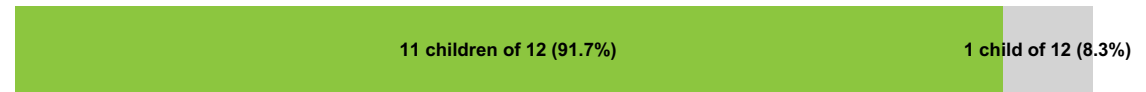


Benchmark 6 - Coordination and Referrals for Other Community Resources and Supports

Construct 19 Percent of primary caregivers with positive screens for IPV (construct 14) who receive referral information to IPV resources.



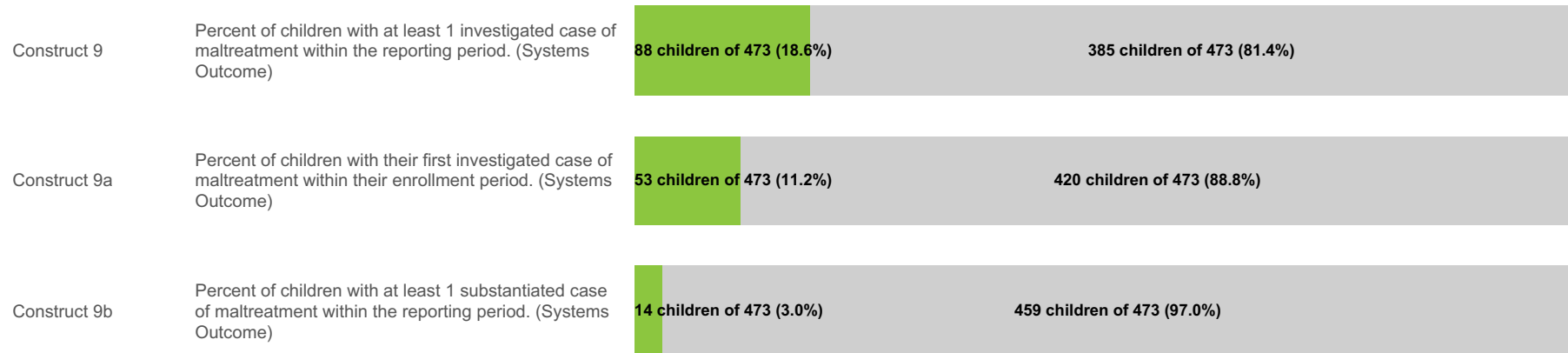
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Benchmark 2 - Child Maltreatment Breakdown



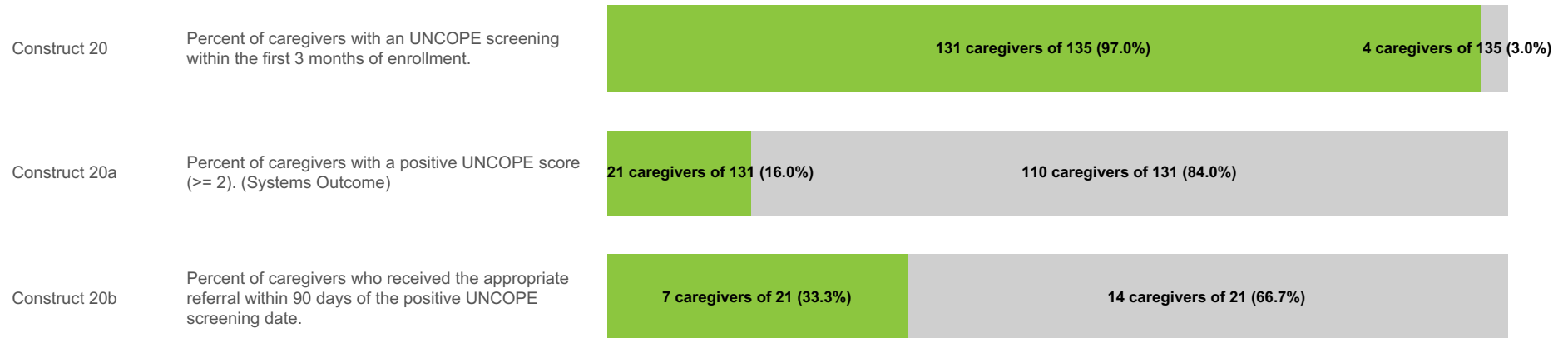
