CONTENT: The Nebraska Legislature changed the funding stream for ADRC funds in the 2022

> session. Due to the timing of this change, the SUA will issue awards to the aging and partner organizations directly in SFY23 at the SFY22 levels. This information was shared with participating organizations during budget preparation for SFY23.

This change opens the funding stream to all ADRC participants, and the process

will change to a competitive grant process beginning in SFY24.

The Nebraska State Unit on Aging will be issuing sub-awards for Aging and Disability Resource Center Programs for FY 2024-2027 based on a competitive grant process. This will involve interested applicants submitting a proposal as well as an application for evaluation. Please see the attached Draft Nebraska Aging and Disability Resource Center Program Request for Information for an overview of the timeframes associated with this process and information regarding program requirements. Please note that this is a draft only and a full request for information will be provided at a later date.
