SUBJECT: Notice of Public Hearing – 180 NAC 18

The purpose of these hearings is to receive comments on proposed Title 180 of Nebraska Administrative Code (NAC) Chapters 18. The proposed changes update definitions; update fees; modify terminology; remove all duplicate statutory, unnecessary, and inconsistent language from the regulations; update section headings; correct typographical and punctuation errors; and update formatting. Authority for these regulations is found in <a href="Neb:-Rev. Stat.">Neb:-Rev. Stat.</a> § 81-3117(7).

## TITLE 180 – CONTROL OF RADIATION

- 180 NAC 18 Fees for Certificates of Registration, Radioactive Material Licenses, Environmental Surveillance, Emergency Response and Other Regulatory Services
  - Updated definitions.
  - Corrected typographical and punctuation errors.
  - Removed unnecessary and repetitive language, and updated formatting throughout the chapter.
  - 180 NAC 18-005.01 table item 26 radioactive material application and license fee category of "Other Specific License" was modified by adding the words "Not Requiring a Decommissioning Funding Plan or Financial Assurance for Decommissioning".
  - Reduction of Dental X-ray fees in 180 NAC 18-008.01.
  - Reduction of Cabinet X-ray fees in 180 NAC 008.01 item 4.b.
  - Reduction of Service registrant fees in 180 NAC 18-008.02.

Yearly fees to registrants mentioned above are proposed to be reduced as follows:

Service Type Fees (Service Registrations) \$100.00/service type
Dental X-ray Machines \$15.00/machine
Cabinet X-ray Machines \$50.00/machine
Therapy Units \$100.00/unit
