Children and Family Services Case Manager Turnover

This report illustrates the monthly Child Protective Services Children and Family Service Specialists (CFSS) case manager monthly turnover rates for 2022 & 2023. Positions include CFS Specialists, Child Abuse Hotline, APS, B2i & Trainees within each category. Counts exclude Supervisors and Administrators.

The data are expressed as a count and proportion of CFS Specialists that are no longer in the position from the prior month. Those not in the position may have been promoted or accepted a different position, or separated their employment from DHHS. Turnover rates in the charts below are limited to the DHHS CFS Specialists position.
