Member of the faculty of a college or university located in Nebraska who is actively engaged in a teaching program relating to business administration, social work, gerontology, or some other aspect of the administration of health care facilities 2. Resident of Nebraska for one (1) year and shall remain a resident of Nebraska while serving as a board member
Nonprofit Home Member	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Active license to practice as a nursing home administrator in Nebraska for the five (5) years just preceding appointment and shall maintain this license while serving as a board member 2. Actively engaged in the practice of nursing home administration for the five (5) years just preceding appointment and shall maintain such practice while serving as a board member. Active practice means devoting a substantial portion of time to rendering professional services 3. Resident of Nebraska for one (1) year and shall remain a resident of Nebraska while serving as a board member 4. Employed in the management or operation of a nonprofit home for the aged or infirm or nursing home or hospital caring for chronically ill or infirm, aged patients
Physician Member	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Active license to practice as a physician in Nebraska for the five (5) years just preceding appointment and shall maintain this license while serving as a board member 2. Actively engaged in the practice of medicine and surgery for the five (5) years just preceding appointment and shall maintain such practice while serving as a board member. Active practice means devoting a substantial portion of time to rendering professional services 3. Resident of Nebraska for one (1) year and shall remain a resident of Nebraska while serving as a board member 4. Demonstrated interest in long-term care
Proprietary Home Member	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Active license to practice as a nursing home administrator in Nebraska for the five (5) years just preceding appointment and shall maintain this license while serving as a board member. 2. Actively engaged in the practice of nursing home administration for the five (5) years just preceding appointment and shall maintain such practice while serving as a board member. Active practice means devoting a substantial portion of time to rendering professional services. 3. Resident of Nebraska for one (1) year and shall remain a resident of Nebraska while serving as a board member. 4. Employed in the management, operation, or ownership of a proprietary home for the aged or infirm or nursing home that serves the aged or infirm in Nebraska
Public Member	<p>At the time of appointment and while serving as a public member, an individual shall meet the following requirements.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Resident of Nebraska for one (1) year and remain a resident of Nebraska while serving as a board member 2. At least nineteen (19) years of age 3. Represent the interests and viewpoints of the public 4. SHALL NOT hold an active credential in any profession or business which is subject to the Uniform Credentialing Act, issued in Nebraska or in any other jurisdiction, at any time during the five (5) years prior to appointment 5. SHALL NOT be eligible for appointment to a board which regulates a profession or business in which that person has ever held a credential 6. SHALL NOT be or not have been, at any time during the year prior to appointment, an employee of a member of a profession credentialed by the department, of a facility credentialed pursuant to the Health Care Facility Licensure Act, or of a business credentialed pursuant to the Uniform Credentialing Act 7. SHALL NOT be the parent, child, spouse, or household member of any person presently regulated by the board to which the appointment is being made 8. SHALL HAVE NO material financial interest in the profession or business regulated by this board 9. SHALL NOT be a member or employee of the legislative or judicial branch of state government.
Registered Nurse Member	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Active license to practice as a registered nurse in Nebraska for the five (5) years just preceding appointment and shall maintain this license while serving as a board member. 2. Actively engaged in the practice of registered nursing for the five (5) years just preceding appointment and shall maintain such practice while serving as a board member. Active practice means devoting a substantial portion of time to rendering professional services. 3. Resident of Nebraska for one (1) year and shall remain a resident of Nebraska while serving as a board member.
