## PRACTICE QUESTION(S)

What is the Board's position and /or any existing guidance or regulations as it pertains to the prophylactic prescribing of medication kits, which almost always include antibiotics?

1. Does the Board consider this kind of prescribing via a telemedicine visit to be an acceptable standard of care and safe practice? Or would it be considered unprofessional conduct?

2. Would the Board place any specific restrictions or prohibitions on what medications could be prescribed prophylactically and/or on the amount of a medication that can be prescribed at a given time?

3. Are prescriptions issued for prophylactic purposes without a demonstrated need in the immediate future considered prescriptions issued for a "valid medical purpose?"

The Board of Medicine and Surgery would like to remind the public that we are a complaint driven Board. However, it is the opinion of the Board that they do not consider blanket prescribing individuals without individualized medical rational to be acceptable practice. Prescribing is a case-by-case basis not on a blanket prescribing basis, it would not be the standard of care.
